

**David L. Hayes, MD, FACC, FACP, FHRS**, is Professor of Medicine at Mayo College of Medicine in Rochester, Minnesota. Dr. Hayes's expertise includes cardiac implantable devices, cardiac pacing, defibrillation, and resynchronization therapy. As Medical Director of Mayo Clinic Provider Relations, Dr. Hayes leads development of the Mayo Clinic Care Network and Mayo Clinic International Relationships. He is currently developing an affiliated practice network for the Mayo Clinic, which includes 46 healthcare organizations in 23 states and 4 international sites.

Dr. Hayes is Immediate Past Chair of the Mayo Clinic Cardiovascular Division, Past President of the Heart Rhythm Society, and Past President of the North American Society of Pacing and Electrophysiology. He is a member of the Heart Rhythm Society, American College of Cardiology, American Heart Association Council on Cardiology, and a former member of the North American Society of Pacing and Electrophysiology.

A sought-after speaker, Dr. Hayes has delivered local, regional, national, and international presentations primarily devoted to topics in cardiac rhythm. He is the author or coauthor of more than 300 peer-reviewed manuscripts and 470 abstracts. His articles and abstracts are published in prestigious, peer-reviewed scientific journals, including *Circulation*, *Journal of the American College of Cardiology*, and *New England Journal of Medicine*. Dr. Hayes also is a member of the editorial boards for *Intelligence Reports in Clinical Pacing and Electrophysiology*, *Pacing and Clinical Electrophysiology*, and *Journal of Cardiovascular Electrophysiology*. He is a reviewer for *Journal of the American College of Cardiology*, *New England Journal of Medicine*, *Pacing and Clinical Electrophysiology*, *Circulation*, *Critical Care Medicine*, *International Journal of Cardiology*, *British Heart Journal*, *European Journal of Echocardiography*, and *Chest*, among others.

Dr. Hayes earned his BA in biology at the University of Missouri and he earned his MD with distinction at the University of Missouri School of Medicine in Kansas City. He completed his internship and residency in internal medicine and his residency in cardiovascular diseases at the Mayo Graduate School of Medicine. A Mayo Foundation Scholar, Dr. Hayes completed his fellowship in cardiac pacing at Montefiore Medical Center and his fellowship in nuclear cardiology at Cornell University Medical Center/New York Hospital. He also completed a traveling fellowship at the Surgical Clinic Val d'Or in Saint Cloud, France.

Dr. Hayes is the recipient of the University of Missouri School of Medicine E. Grey Dimond, MD, Take Wing Award and the American Academy of Medical Administrators Nycomed Amersham Award for Excellence and Honorary Fellowship.
