

Linda D. Gillam, MD, MPH, FACC, FAHA, FESC, FASE is the Dorothy and Lloyd Huck Chair of Cardiovascular Medicine at Morristown Medical Center / Atlantic Health System in Morristown, New Jersey. In addition, Dr. Gillam is Professor of Medicine at Thomas Jefferson University Sidney Kimmel School of Medicine in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

Dr. Gillam's clinical interests include valvular heart disease, heart disease in women, and echocardiography. A sought-after speaker, she has delivered local, regional, national, and international invited presentations in her field. She is Associate Editor of *Circulation: Cardiovascular Imaging*, Imaging Editor for the American College of Cardiology website, and Co-editor of Advanced Echocardiographic Techniques and Essential Echocardiography.

Dr. Gillam is President of the National Board of Echocardiography and Past President of the American Society of Echocardiography (ASE).
