Dr. Robert D Schaller is Associate Professor of Clinical Medicine at the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania where he serves as the director of device therapy and extraction and the co-director of the clinical research program. His focus is on the care of patients with heart rhythm disorders and specializes in ablation of complex atrial and ventricular arrhythmias as well as lead and device management, with a focus on lead extraction.

Dr. Schaller has published extensively on the topics of ablation, device therapy, and lead extraction, with an emphasis on safety, efficacy, and adoption of new tools and techniques. He has published over 100 peer reviewed manuscripts in *Heart Rhythm Journal*, *JAMA Cardiology*, *JACC Electrophysiology*, *Circulation Arrhythmia and Electrophysiology*, *Journal of Cardiac Electrophysiology*, and *Europace*, among others.
